

Child welfare protection fund established

An amount of Rs. 900,000 about 90 0000 skr has been collected in the 'Child Welfare Fund' established by Child Workers in Nepal Concerned Centre (CWIN) at the main initiation of the transport entrepreneurs, state-owned national news agency RSS reported Tuesday.

CWIN is a non-governmental organization working in the child rights, child protection and rehabilitation sectors.
